



## Tournament-Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can I bring **coolers** into the park?  
Teams are allowed 1 team cooler in the player/dugout area. We do offer a full concession stand for refreshments inside the gated sports complex during the games. Coolers are also allowed in the parking lot for tailgating.
2. Can I bring **tents**?  
Tents are allowed as long as they do not obstruct the view of others and they are weighted down (stakes are not allowed)
3. How much does it **cost** to come in?  
There is no charge for the park itself. The tournament price to enter the sport complex (watch games) is determined and collected by the tournament. Please contact the tournament director with questions.
4. Do you have **concessions**?  
We do provide concessions during ball games
5. Can I bring my dog (**pet**)?  
Dogs are not allowed inside the baseball/soccer gated sport complexes. However, they are allowed in the park common areas as long as they are leashed, and inside the dog parks.
6. Can I **park** my RV, trailer, or boat here?  
No oversized vehicle parking space is available. Parking is allowed only in designated areas. Each vehicle must be within a single parking space. Trailers must be detached and parked within a single space.
7. Are there **cameras** to watch my son/daughters game?  
There are live streaming cameras on all baseball/softball fields. These are also equipped with microphones on each field. Cameras can be viewed at [www.nmbpark.com](http://www.nmbpark.com).
8. Why are the **scoreboards** not on?  
Scoreboard use is determined by the tournament director.
9. What does the **horn** mean?  
The horn is a lightning detection system. The system detects lightning within 8 miles of the Park. When a single horn sounds and the light is on all persons should leave the complex and go to their vehicles for cover. Once the horn sounds 3 times and the light goes out it is safe to return to the field.
