## How are Jr. Counselor's Chosen?

The Jr. Counselor Program is limited to a maximum of 6 Jr. Counselors per week. Admittance is through a competitive process that will include a written component and an interview process. We are looking for enthusiastic and mature individuals who want to serve as a positive role model for our campers as well as provide assistance to camp staff.

## How long will the program run?

The Jr. Counselor Program will run an overall 10 weeks throughout the summer. Jr. Counselors are required to complete a minimum of 5 full weeks in order to participate in the program. Jr. Counselors are required to attend Monday through Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm but can arrive as early at 7:30am and stay until 5:30pm.

## What will a Jr. Counselor's main responsibilities be?

Jr. Counselors will assist and shadow camp staff to help with daily activities and to learn basic job skills. They will learn how to lead games, help with activities setup and cleanup, and assist in taking campers to and from various locations throughout the AFC. Jr. Counselors will create and complete a community wide project throughout the summer. Jr. Counselors will also complete a reflection journal by the end of the program.
